

Rotary Club Seohara Sampurna, RI District 3100, Uttar Pradesh, India, successfully completed Global Grant Project No. GG2574049 titled **“In Service of BE&L – Computer Systems, Smart Boards, Solar Panel & Girls’ Toilet Block Project.”** The project was implemented at Madhur Memorial Public School, Seohara, with a total project cost of INR 2,962,215.00 and completed in March 2026.

Under the project, a computer laboratory equipped with educational software was established, smart boards were installed to enhance digital learning, solar panels were set up to ensure sustainable energy supply, and a dedicated girls’ toilet block was constructed to improve sanitation and promote a better learning environment for female students.
